



Impact hinterland strategy



Observations 1. Intermodal transport (infrastructure) crucial for realizing / maintaining market shares in more distant hinterlands; 2. Port authority ideally situated to take active role, stimulate intermodal transport and act as knowledge centre; 3. Deep sea terminal ideally situated to bundle containers on trains; 4. Container routes are often difficult to influence on the short run.

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
