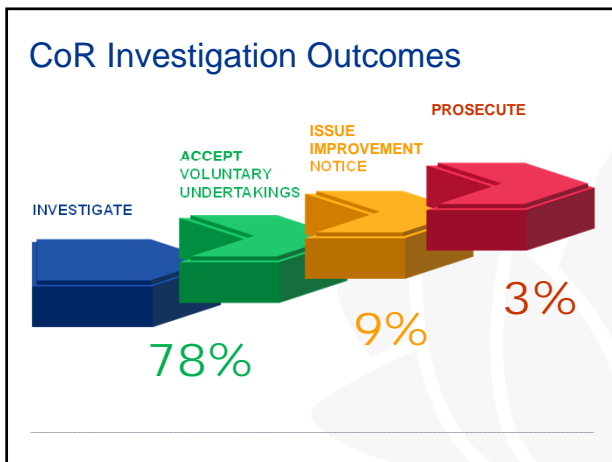
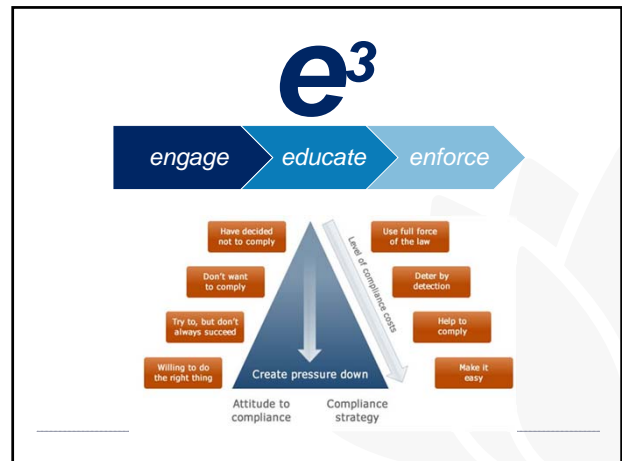

CoR Prosecutions

Mass Offences – Approved Routes - Sentencing on 26 February 2018:

26 non-compliances with approved routes for SPV, travelling across vulnerable assets

Parties:

- Operator - \$50K
- Director #1 - \$5K
- Director #2 - \$5K
- Costs awarded against parties = \$35K

Total financial penalties = \$95K

CoR Prosecutions

Mass Offences - Sentencing on 28 February 2018:

Discovered hidden book which recorded actual weighbridge weights, which were then falsified to give appearance of compliance

Parties:

- Operator - \$805K, Supervisory Intervention Order
- Consignor - \$745K
- Director - \$31K, 12 month Prohibition Order
- Costs awarded against parties = \$53K

Total financial penalties = \$1.634M

CoR Prosecutions

Speed and Fatigue Offences - Sentencing on 13 March 2018:

2015 fatal crash on the Hume Highway north of Yass involving the collision of a B-Double operated by the accused and two light vehicles

Parties:

- Operator - \$187K
- Director #1 - \$4.5K, 6 month Prohibition Order
- Director #2 - \$1.3K
- Costs awarded against parties = \$100K

Total financial penalties = \$293K



CoR Prosecutions

Failure to Produce Offences – Obstruction of Investigation - Sentencing on 3 May 2018:

4 fail to produce documents and 4 fail to produce information relating to vehicle defects and work diary breaches which were unable to be appropriately investigated

Parties:

- Operator - \$80K
- Director - \$20K
- Costs awarded against parties = \$16K

Total financial penalties = \$116K
